

A Future with or without Technology?






Intro
















STEP 1: BUILD A TEAM



Role description

At the beginning, each team member is assigned a role, which they have until the end. You can see from the pictograms which role has the most to do here.

IMPORTANT: Nevertheless, work on all tasks together. Be inspiring for each other!



Secretary: As secretary, you should take notes for all tasks that have the sign /. Decide together in the group what you want to write down. Then write it down in the space provided.



Moderator: As the moderator of the group, you take on an organizational role. You ensure that all tasks are completed together. You also take the lead in longer discussions. You can tell from the sign when you should take on your role as moderator.



Timekeeper: As a timekeeper, your job is to keep an eye on the time. You will find the time allotted for each worksheet in the top right-hand corner with the \circ sign . If a discussion takes too long, let your group know.




